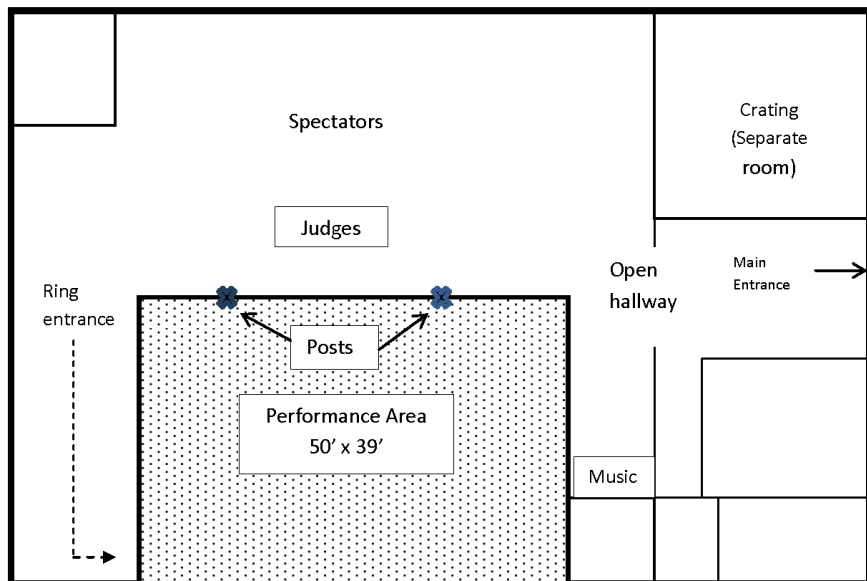

“In The Moment” Class

- “In The Moment” is a Pass/Fail, non-titling class.
- The class will be judged by one judge and one certified instructor or provisional judge, on a Pass/Fail basis and will not receive a numerical score. Participants will be allowed to watch other entries, except during the time they choose to warm up their dog.
- No music will be played. The improv will have a **concept** and an **intent**, these being randomly drawn or assigned at the beginning of each entry’s turn. Within one minute of receiving these, the team will move briskly into the performance space, honor, and proceed directly to an opening shape.
- The maximum time is one (1) minute, with no minimum. Handler’s recognition of having solved the problem, and drawing to a closing shape is of much greater value than extending the duration of the improv.
- The “In the Moment” Class will be held following presentation of the Awards at the end of the Titling Event on Saturday, November 2.
- Entries will be \$10.00. Check the box for “In The Moment Class” and include the fee in your total paid amount.

Entry fees per show: each dog may have one individual dog entry and may be a member of more than one Multiple Dog entry of differing combinations of dogs.

Individual Dog classes: \$40.00 per class (CFF member \$35.00)

Multiple Dog classes: \$40.00 first dog (CFF member \$35.00)

\$10.00 each additional dog; maximum of \$60.00 per entry

Multiple Dog entries must include a separate entry form for each dog, stapled together. Entry forms must be complete and include both sides. Incomplete entry forms will be returned.

‘NEW’- PhraseWork Class — (offered Saturday on a trial basis)

- Entrants should come from a CFF-sanctioned class, with instructor initialing approval on the entry form for any entrant who has never earned a title. It will not be judged, but comments may be requested.
- Performance may be done on or off lead. CFF guidelines regarding collars, props, etc. must be adhered to.
- Entries will be \$10.00. Check the box for “PhraseWork Class” on the entry form and include fee with your total. Music must be submitted to the music steward in advance, as in any of the regular classes.
- Each team will be allowed up to one minute to acclimate to the performance area. The use of a toy would be permitted during this acclimation period.
- After the acclimation period, toy is relinquished, team moves to the center to honor and then moves to its starting position, assumes opening shape, and cues the music.
- There is no minimum performance length; maximum is one minute.
- Performance should not be just a string of ‘tricks’ or ‘moves’ set to music, but rather a discrete phrase with a beginning, middle, and end.

Directions

From Greensboro and Points East: On Bus I-40 westbound, take Exit 6B (52N/US311N toward Mt. Airy). Take Exit 115B, University Parkway South. Go 1.6 miles and turn right onto Bethabara Park Blvd. Go ~1 mile and turn left onto Bethania Station Road (railroad tracks/stop light). The club building is immediately on the right.

From Statesville and Points West: On I-40 eastbound, keep left at Exit 188 (Bus I-40E/US-421S toward Winston Salem). Take Exit 2B and stay left on the exit ramp (67W/Silas Creek Pkwy N). As you approach the second stoplight (~3.3 mile) at the Silas Creek Parkway and 67W split, keep left to stay on Silas Creek. At the second stoplight (~1.7 mile), turn left onto Bethabara Road. After the one lane road in Bethabara Park, turn right at the stop sign onto Bethania Station Road. The club building is one block ahead on the left.

Notice to Exhibitors

Telegraph, telephone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Mail all entries with fees to Show Secretary, Shari Bryant, 627 Morgan Summers Road, Gibsonville, NC 27249. All checks and money orders are to be made payable in U.S. funds to Carolina Canine Freestyle Guild. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. **Closing time and date for entries. Entries close at 6 PM Saturday, October 12, 2019, at the home of the secretary.** Entries cannot be accepted, canceled, or substituted after this time. Entry fees will be returned for anyone not selected. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Competition Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made. Post-dated checks and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of the returned check. Subsequent checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. **Declination of entries.** The Canine Freestyle Federation Inc. may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause and no one shall have any recourse against the Canine Freestyle Federation Inc. or any official thereof. **Errors on entry blanks.** Owners are responsible for errors in making out the entry forms and no entry fees will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Consult the Judging Program for time of judging. Exhibitors must check in with ring steward at least 10 minutes prior to the start of their class or be marked absent. Exhibitors must be governed by any rules or regulations of civil authorities and building and parking restrictions. Vehicles parked contrary to regulations will be subject to ticketing and towing at owner's expense.

All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged. Every effort will be made to maintain a calm, quiet environment out of respect for the dogs that are being exhibited. If, in the opinion of the officers of the host guild, a dog is creating a disturbance, these officers may require the owner or agent to remove the dog from the building, or from the premises. No refund will be granted for an entered dog that is removed because it is causing a disturbance.

The Joan Tennille Artistic Challenge Trophy

For the highest artistic score in a regular class—single dog division: a Waterford Crystal G Clef on a wooden base. Offered by Carl Tennille.

This trophy will be offered at all CFF shows. The winner's name and dog's name will be engraved on the plaque for display at future trials. A suitable trophy offered by Carl Tennille will be awarded to commemorate the win. If the trophy is won three times by the same handler, not necessarily with the same dog and not at consecutive shows, a Sterling Silver G Clef on a necklace will be awarded.

The Sally Kirschenman Award

A Challenge Trophy known as the Sally Kirschenman Award is offered by CFF at each show for the highest scoring single or brace team in regular classes.
